Items for discussion were as follows:

- Mr. Taton reported to the board on several items
 - Matt has heard back from several groups that uniform pants and plumes can be acquired very economically.
 - It is very possible that practices will be scheduled for Saturday's that do not have a competitions scheduled.
 - The homecoming parade will be September 28 at the school again this year.
 - So far this year the roster is at 71 kids with the possibility of adding a few more students once school starts, last year the band marched with 79 members.
 - Overall Mr. Taton, the staff, the students, and the parents felt the camp was very well run this year and very successful.
 - The necessary forms are being completed; Matt will follow up with students to make sure all forms are turned in.
 - The music of this year's program is from Pink Floyd and will include the songs In The Flesh, Another brick In The Wall #1 & #2, and Comfortably Numb.
 - It is very likely there will be no Winter Guard, or Drum Line this year.
 - December 7, 2007 the school will host the CMU Brass Band, and the Mountain Town Singers (**corrected 9/11/07; was December 9, 2007 in original minutes**).
 - There is a current job posting for a new Orchestra Director at the High School.

- Water, cups, and seat covers are set for the game on Thursday August 30, 2007.

- The board discussed the possibility of participating in a fundraiser at Buffalo Wild Wings. The board is concerned that a fundraiser at a bar would have an unfavorable reflection upon the music programs. Sallie is to check with the High School principal to see what his feelings about a fundraiser at Buffalo Wild Wings are.
