The year 2015 will mark the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Community Memorial Stadium here in Mt. Pleasant. This field holds the memories of fifty years of *football, track and field events and all of the activity* that surrounds these events. As a supporter of the music programs at the Mt. Pleasant Public Schools you enjoyed the memories that have been created at half time but more important the discipline and talent the music programs provide.

In celebration of the 50 years for the stadium an initiative has been created. The Pillars of the Community Stadium Improvement Project was recently formed to secure funding for synthetic turf that will support all existing activities and would be durable enough to potentially **host marching band invites. More importantly a synthetic turf field will provide safe and consistent conditions which the marching band can utilize for practice throughout the season.** The goal for this project is to raise \$750,000. This money will improve the entrance of the stadium, new score board with advertising, and enhanced track and field area. We hope to achieve this goal by building a brick wall inside the stadium utilizing bricks purchased by donors. Your contribution can be as small or as large as you like. If you would like your name or that of a loved one forever tied to the stadium there are two levels of bricks that can be purchased for either \$250 or \$1000 Pillars along the wall are available by larger or corporate donors at \$10,000 for a short pillar and \$25,000 for a tall pillar.

Together let's give our Community Memorial Stadium another fifty years of memories. *Let's work together to preserve the pride and history of the Mt.
